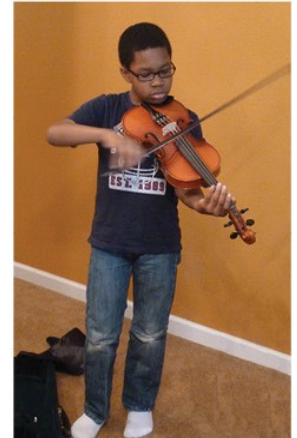
Summer Planning Meeting
